

Maleny Garden Club – Gardening on the Edge – Saturday 12 & Sunday 13 June 2010 – Gardens & Features

**Garden 1 - Blue Wren Cottage & Blomsterhaven
9-11 Walkers Drive Maleny**

*Two merging gardens of different styles that highlight what can be achieved on town-sized blocks and within the budget. Blue Wren Cottage- a rambling cottage style with winding pathways evolving to sculptured clipped avenues. Shady nooks and bowers filled with colourful features.
Blomsterhaven - a more open style garden with beds hugging the fence line and open lawns for the kids chooks, veggie garden and tree house.
Both half acre gardens are abundant with camellias, magnolias, fuchsias, tree begonias, bromeliads and an array of annuals and perennials. Both locations enjoy the rural scenes of grazing herds and green hills for which the area is famous.*

**Garden 2 - Mountain View Hideaway
17 Mountain View Rd Maleny**

*Overlooking the Glasshouse Mountains, our home is built on a secluded sloping 4 ac site. It overlooks a formal courtyard surrounded beyond by large beds of perennials, & shrubs. A productive orchard supplies the household needs & terraced beds show off varieties of camellias, magnolias, azaleas, viryeas, peiris, euphorbias & hibiscus at their best. Garden statuary adds further dimension to the expansive areas of lawn.

**Garden 3 - Garth
15 Beechwood Road Maleny**

A mix of Owner planted rainforest and landscaped gardens. Well developed Stephanotis embrace a pergola near the front entrance. The front garden is more formal with clipped low hedges of Gardenia, Magnolia and miniature Orange Jessamine as well as standards of Gardenias and Iceberg Roses. An avenue of Tropical Birches lead to a private garden rimmed with Naylor's Blue Conifers and clipped Fruit Salad Magnolias with prostrate Bauhinia on the bank.

**Garden 4 – Montville Macadamery
41 Mill Hill Rd Montville**

A fully restored Queenslander built in 1926 in a 20 hectare rainforest setting including 7 hectares of manicured semi - tropical gardens and a rainforest boardwalk. Species include mature plantings of Poinciana, Frangipani, Palms, Tree Ferns, variegated Trachelospemum Repens, potted Pandanus, Yuccas, Cordylines, Photinia Sasanqua, Syzgium hedges, perennial dianthus, Clivias, Hippeastrums, Day Lilies and deep purple Bougainvillea spheres.

**Garden 5 – The Shambles
85 Western Avenue Montville**

A unique country garden containing hundreds of different traditional plant varieties around a century old cottage including heritage roses, species Camellias ,temperate climate plants such as Rhododendron, Pieris , Osmanthus ,Deutzia and Weigela, salvias and perennials. 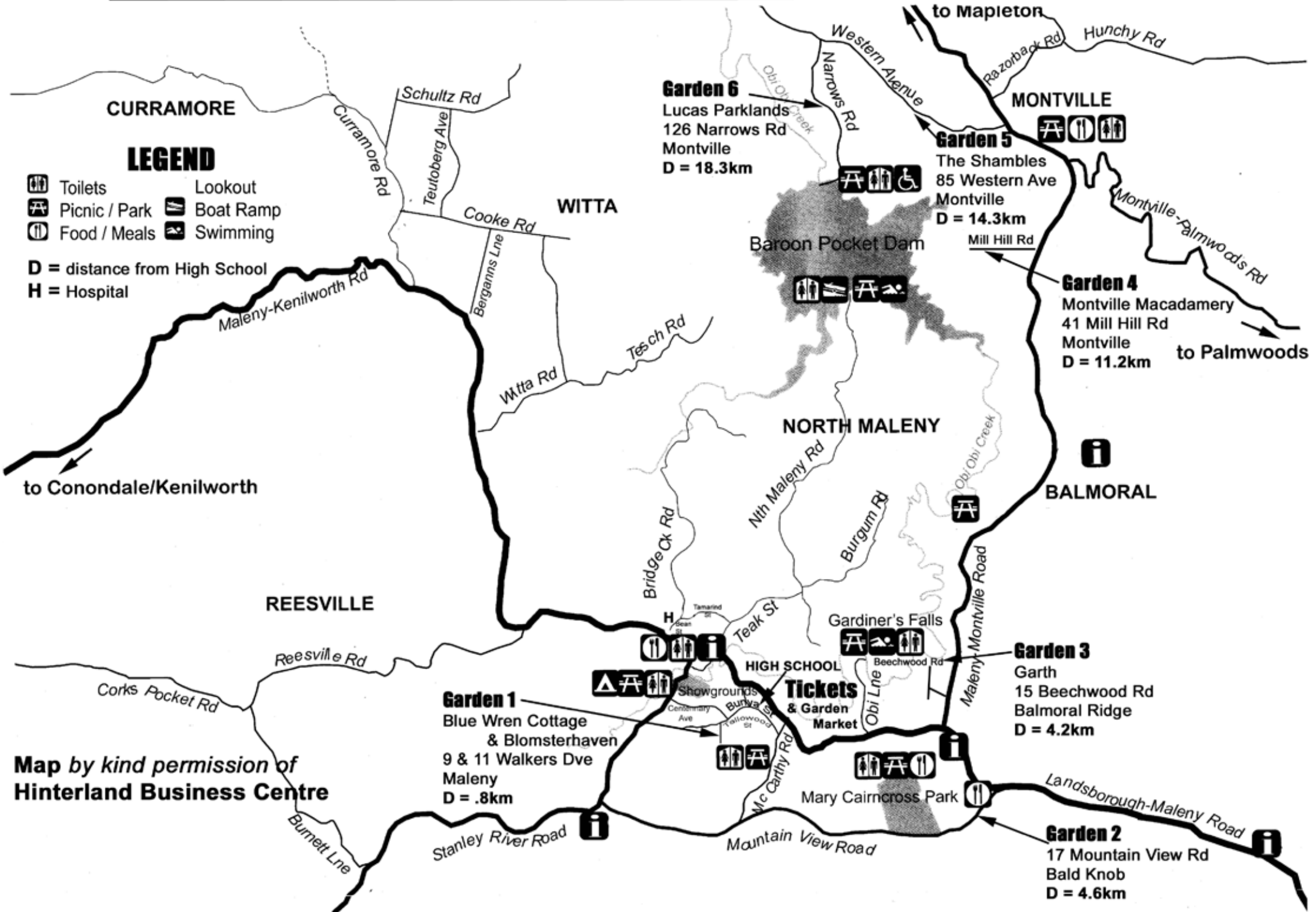
Garden Market – Bunya St Maleny
